CARLOS BANNON BLAZQUEZ

Carlos Bañón Blazquez plays a pivotal role in pushing the boundaries of modern architecture by merging art, technology, and education. He is a professor of architecture at the Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD), where he teaches architectural design and advanced technologies.

He is also a co-founder of Subarquitectura, a globally recognized architectural firm known for its innovative and creative designs. Among his many international accolades, one of the most prestigious is the Presidents' Design Award in Singapore. He received this award in 2020 for the AirMesh Pavilion, located in Gardens by the Bay. This pavilion is one of the worlds' first fully functional spatial structures built using 3D printing, serving as a landmark example of future construction techniques and the fusion of built and natural environments for a more sustainable future.

His other notable projects include:

Redefining Parks – a project that reimagines urban park spaces, blending modern design with ecological concepts.

Schools of Nature – an initiative that envisions schools as environments in harmony with nature, emphasizing children's interaction with natural surroundings.

Carlos Bañón is an active contributor to global conferences, where he frequently presents papers and delivers lectures on the intersection of architecture, technology, and innovation.
