AI Artist, Architect, and Designer (India)

Manas Bhatia is an Indian artist and architect from Dehradun, India, currently pursuing a Master of Science in Computational Design Practices (MS CDP) at Columbia GSAPP in New York. His research focuses on generative AI in collaborative design and social interaction within architectural spaces.

Previously, Manas worked as an associate at Ant Studio, India, leading various projects ranging from public art installations to climate-responsive systems such as CoolAnt. He is internationally recognized for his pioneering work in AI-driven architecture and design, with features in CNN, BBC, and Dezeen. His works have been showcased in international exhibitions, including the 2023 Borders Art Fair and an ongoing exhibition at Château de Lourmarin, France.

He has delivered lectures on AI in architecture at institutions like OP Jindal University, the University of Toronto, and Oxford Saïd Business School. He has also worked on custom AI-driven design projects for companies like Google Italy and appeared in the PBS documentary "A Brief History of the Future".

In 2024, he was nominated for Forbes Asia 30 Under 30 in the Arts category.
